

# DIRECTIONS TO POWYS PODS

GRUG FARM, BRYNGWYN, KINGTON, POWYS HR5 3QN

## 1. Travelling from HEREFORD (and Gloucester)

Follow the signposts for **Brecon** along the **A438**. At the village of **Clyro** (near Hay-on-Wye) turn right just after speed limit signs as you enter the village, then IMMEDIATELY right again up a hill, following the **signs to Newchurch** (as you have crossed over the border signs are in Welsh now too!).

*If you are following a SatNav, it may take you right at the Rhydspence Pub a few miles before Clyro. This shortcut is along a narrow unmaintained road, so we recommend following these directions instead. The Rhydspence road joins onto the Clyro-Newchurch road before the crossroads with the red telephone box.*

*Now go to step 6.*

## 2. Travelling from BRECON or TALGARTH (Llandovery & Newport)

Take the **A470** and then the **A438** from Brecon or the **A438** from Talgarth. Follow the signposts for **Hereford**, turning left over the River Wye in **Glasbury**. You will go through the village of **Llowes** and then arrive in **Clyro**. Continue on the main road past the petrol station and take the **second turn on the left** just before you exit the village, and then turn IMMEDIATELY right following signposts for **Newchurch** up a steep hill.

*Now go to step 6.*

## 3. Travelling from KINGTON (and Leominster)

From **Kington** take the **A44** and then turn **left after 3.5 miles** onto the **B4594 signposted Painscastle**. Follow the road through the villages of **Gladestry** and **Newchurch**, and pass over a crossroads with a **red telephone box**. The main road then heads uphill after going past a farm on the right, and on the brow of this hill turn right up a narrow road to **Bryngwyn Church**.

*Now go to step 7.*

## 4. Travelling from BUILTH WELLS (Llandrindod Wells & Newtown)

From **Builth Wells** take the **A470** south towards **Brecon**. After 7.5 miles turn left over the River Wye BEFORE you get to the village of Erwood. After the bridge take the next right, signposted **Painscastle**. There are some very steep hairpin bends that take you up the hill. After 5.5 miles you will be in **Painscastle**, where the road bends to the left, goes past the Roast Ox pub and continues to **Rhosgoch**. Just as you are leaving the village take a **left turn** signposted **Bryngwyn Church**.

*Now go to step 7.*

## 5. Travelling from the NORTH (Wrexham, Shrewsbury, Bishop's Castle)

You will join the **A44** at **Old Radnor**. Turn left towards **Kington**, and after a downhill bend in the road take a right turn onto the **B4594 signposted Painscastle**. Follow

the road through the villages of **Gladestry** and **Newchurch**, and pass over a crossroads with a **red telephone box**. The main road then heads uphill after going past a farm on the right, and on the brow of this hill turn right up a narrow road to **Bryngwyn Church**.

*Now go to step 7.*

6. When you have turned up the hill in **CLYRO**

Follow this road for 4.5 miles to a crossroads with a red telephone box, then turn left and follow the main road. The main road then heads uphill after going past a farm on the right, and on the brow of this hill turn right up a narrow road to **Bryngwyn Church**.

*Now go to step 7.*

7. When you get to **BRYNGWYN**

At the Church take the turn to **Glascwm**, and go over the cattlegrid onto open common. Then take **second turn on the right** at a grass triangle, and this road leads round to farm. If you get to the green wheelie bin or no-through road sign you have gone too far!

When you have arrived at **POWYS PODS**

The car park is located on the left side of the lane before you pass the camping pods on the left and before you reach the farmhouse. It has two wooden gates at the entrance. You will need to come to the farmhouse or the office in the wooden cabin below the yard to check-in. If no-one is available there will be a note left for you in the farmhouse porch, where you will also find a contact telephone number & phone should you have any queries. The larger Bryn-Gwyn Pod is located adjacent to the car park, Allt Dderw is next to the garden fence, and Ardwyn Pod & Cae Bell pitch are located up the steps on the other side of the road. Please park on the car park & refer to the Welcome Pack in your pod.
